Alarm - Residential	Woodland	2020-03-01	Officer was dispatched to an alarm at the listed residence. Officer confirmed all entries secured and no signs of criminal activity. Alarm report left on scene.
Animal Complaint - Missing Dog - Found	Woodland	2020-03-01	Officer received a phone call regarding a missing dog. Officer spoke with the reporting party who stated that his 10 year old chocolate lab named Oscar had been missing for an hour. Officer searched the area but was unable to locate the dog.
